Biographical Information

Mr. McClelland is a Principal Investment Officer at the Los Angeles County Employee Retirement Association (LACERA) with overall responsibility for the global real estate investment activities of the public pension fund. LACERA is a \$40 billion pension fund benefiting the approximate 130,000 active and retired employees of Los Angeles County. LACERA's real estate investment holdings approximate \$3.7 billion, and included office, retail, industrial, multi-family, single-family and hotel assets situated throughout the United States, Western Europe and Asia.

Prior to re-joining LACERA in 2006 (a position he previously held from 1995-2002), Mr. McClelland was President of CS Capital Management, Inc., the investment management affiliate of Chadwick, Saylor & Company, a real estate investment bank. Mr. McClelland is a 24-year veteran of institutional real estate investing. Prior to joining LACERA, Mr. McClelland served seven years as an Investment Officer for the California State Teachers Retirement System and four years in the acquisitions group of a major pension advisor.

Mr. McClelland is a member of the Counselors of Real Estate and the Pension Real Estate Association (PREA) where he served five years as a member of the association's Board of Directors. Mr. McClelland received a BS degree from UCLA and an MBA from California State University, Sacramento.
