Summer Activities

Rafting: Come navigate the class II whitewater of the Weber River. Experience the thrill of the rapids, scenic geological sites and nature at its best. One guide leads each five-passenger raft. Transportation, gear, and lunch are provided. Trip will last 4-5 hours including lunch. Children must be at least 4 years of age and be able to swim.

Adult: \$70 Child: \$50

Inflatable Kayaks: Paddle the class II whitewater of the Weber River or the Class I Provo in a single or tandem inflatable kayak. Enjoy unique geological formations while you get wet. Transportation, gear, water and lunch are provided. Tour lasts approximately 4-5 hours including lunch. Children must be at least 10 years of age and be able to swim. Our rafting trip is a prerequisite to this tour if you have limited whitewater experience.

Sea Kayaking: Take part in this easy and fun adventure in a sit on top kayak on the beautiful Jordanelle Reservoir. Explore the scenic coves of the Rock Cliff State Park State Park in solo or tandem kayaks. Check out the waterfowl and wildlife along with the learning more about the animals indigenous to our area. This tour lasts 3-4 hours. Transportation, gear, guides, and snacks will be provided. Children must be at least 5 years of age and be able to swim.

Adult: \$70 Child: \$50

Horseback riding: Experience the beauty of the mountains in Park City or Midway. Rides depart throughout the day from 9:00am to 3:00pm and range from the \$40-\$150.00, depending upon whether you choose the hour long, hour and a half or four hour lunch tour. Children must be at least 8 years old. Please call for more information and to make reservations for the ride that best suits you.

Hiking:

Lift Serve Hike: Park City is a haven for hikers. Half-day hikes start with a gondola rides or shuttles to mid-mountain for exploration of the mountains surrounding Park City and unbeatable views. Enjoy spectacular scenery, great photo ops and lush plant and bird life. Guide, snacks, transportation and gondola or lift ride are included.

Historic Mine Hike: If its history that intrigues you, try a nearby hike and brush shoulders with Park City's mining past. See some of the old mine facades and buildings while enjoying Park City's beautiful setting and fresh mountain air. Guide, snacks and transportation are included in this local hike that will be slightly more aerobic.

Uinta Hike: If you are really in the mood to escape the city try one of our guided hikes into the Uinta National Forest, about 30 minutes outside of Park City. Place your feet on the only mountain range in the United States that runs east and west and enjoy a completely different side of Park City, full of amazing mountain vistas for as far as the eye can see and inviting freshwater lakes.

Park City is replete with hiking trails for all levels. Please check with us to discuss alternate options for your hike.

Fly Fishing: Catch the "Zen" as well as the fish on our half and full day trips. Fish the Weber or Provo Rivers with our world class guides. We cater to all experience levels, especially novice, and promise you a day to remember. There is a maximum of 3 guests per guide. Flies, rental equipment, guide, and transportation provided. Lunch with a full day tour.

Biking: There are a variety of exciting options for interested bikers of all levels. Depending on the skill level of the participants, several trails can be accessed.

Beginner Rides:

Historic Rail Trail: Enjoy a mild trail that is great for families or anyone wanting a leisurely ride through the scenic countryside. The ride ends in the town of Wanship, resulting in a total ride length of 13 miles of flat to mildly downhill terrain. Afterwards, the riders enjoy snacks and drinks and are shuttled back to their hotel from Wanship. Usually this tour takes 1 ½ -2hrs.

Deer Creek or Jordanelle Lake Rides: Slightly more exerting and technical than the rail trail, either of these rides will provide an amazing backdrop. The length of the rides will vary based on the client's individual interests.

Intermediate/Advanced Rides:

For more experienced riders miles of varied single track terrain awaits in and around the Park City and Midway areas, including lift access riding at one of our four amazing resorts. Our experienced guides will help you learn the necessary techniques and skills to really enjoy this fantastic form of outdoor adventure. All biking tours are approximately two to two and a half hours, with some variations depending on the ride. The rates are as follows:

Beginner Rides: Adult: \$60.00 Child: \$45.00

Single Track Rides: Adult: \$75.00 \$50.00

Hot Air Ballooning: This is a thrilling experience for the whole family! From a mile up in the sky you will get an amazing view of Park City, the beautiful Wasatch and Uinta Mountains, as well as Salt Lake City. This is an early-morning adventure that departs at 6:30am. The tour includes a champagne toast and first flight certificate. The rates are given below on per person basis children 10 and under are half price:

1/2 hour flight: \$95.00

1 hour flight: \$175.00

ATV Tours: This will really ramp up your stay! If you're interested in a faster paced adventure where you can really kick up some dirt join us on a 2hr tour at The Canyons Resort in Park City. See great views the area from every angle. Single and double machines available. Easy to drive. No experience necessary.

Olympic Park Tour: Come join us for a tour of the Utah's Olympic Park. Guided tours, athletes training, Bobsleigh rides, and the Alf Engen ski museum is all on the list at this 2002 Olympic Games Venue. Transportation and Guide provided.
\$25.00 per person with a 4 person minimum.

Salt Lake City Tour: Take a tour of the city that hosted the 2002 Olympic Winter Games. You'll also be visiting the world famous Mormon Church Visitors center and many other Salt Lake City attractions. Tour includes time for lunch. Transportation and guide provided. Custom Tours can also be arranged to suit your personal needs. Minimum of three people or payment for three people required.
\$75.00/per person not including lunch.

Trap Shoot: Enjoy shooting clay pigeons from a rustic trap shooting range in Kamas, Utah located 20 minutes from Park City. Choose from an over and under, pump, or single shot 12-gauge shotgun. Range time is 1-2 hours in length. This price also includes 2 boxes of shells per person. More shells will be available upon request.

\$85.00 per person and requires 8 person minimum to do this event.

Geo Caching, Scavenger Hunts: Old fashion clues or high-tech GPS tracking devices will help you discover the treasure of the Canyons or Historic Park City. Guide will assist you in your adventure. This great activity for your family or company lasts 2-3 hours and can be tailored specifically to your group's interests and needs. Snacks and water will be provided. \$60/person

Mirror Lake Scenic Drive: If you want to see the lush Uinta mountain range in a leisurely manner this trip is perfect for you! Join us for a loop through the Mirror Lake Scenic Byway with lunch at one of the many lakes dotting the forest. We will then continue on to Evanston Wyoming and back down I-80 on our return to Park City. Lunch, transportation and guide included. Tour will last 3-4 hours. Two person minimum required.

Timpanogos Cave National Monument/Cascade Springs Extravaganza:

On this tour you will have the opportunity to pass by Bridal Veil Falls on the way to visiting Robert Redford's famous Sundance Resort, eat lunch at some of the Wasatch Mountain's lively natural water springs and explore the fascinating stalactites and stalagmites formed inside of Timpanogos Cave; the heart of Utah's glacial Mt. Timpanogos. Timpanogos cave requires a 1 ½ mile hike. This trip departs in the morning on specific days and will last 4-5 hours; please call us for details. Lunch, transportation, entrance fees and guide included. Two person minimum required.

Package Tours

Double the Pleasure and Double the Fun when you double up on our activities!!!

Bike and Float: Departure time for this activity is at 9:00 am. This full day package begins with an easy and scenic 13-mile biking tour on the Park City Rail Trail to the small town of Wanship. A shuttle will meet the bikers in Wanship and have lunch ready for them. After lunch, the bikers will be transported to Henefer, the put-in location for the rafting trip. The rafting trips are done on the Class II whitewater of the Weber River and are approximately an hour and a half to two hours in length. Return time to the hotel will be about 4:00 pm. Adult: \$125.00 Child: \$75.00

Bike and Kayak: Who Join us and enjoy a leisurely ride around the lake before jumping in and paddling your kayak or, for more breathtaking views and added adrenaline, bike the smooth single track trails from Deer Valley's Solamere area down to the Jordanelle Reservoir. After your bike ride you will sit down to a leisurely lunch at the Jordanelle marina and then suit up for a pleasant paddle through Jordanelle's cool waters. This tour will last 5-6 hours and includes transportation, equipment, guide, and lunch.
Adults: \$125.00 Children 12 and under: \$75.00

Hike and Slide: Join us for a scenic lift ride at Park City Mountain resort to see some of our historic mine facades. Continue on the tour enjoying a hike through lush foliage until you come to the Alpine slide where you will have a chance to push your adrenaline to the limit speeding down the Alpine Slide. Snacks, water, guide, Alpine Slide pass, lift ride and transportation included. \$55 per person

Rock and Raft: Try your hands at some rock climbing before cooling off on a rafting trip down the Weber River. No experience necessary. Join us in the Uinta Mountains for a truly rocking experience climbing with our experienced guides amid fantastic mountain scenery. Take a break for lunch at one of our favorite local cafés and then head out to the river for 1 ½ hours of fun floating and navigating rapids. Tour lasts about 7 hours.
\$175.00 (Two person minimum required.)

Cowboy Day: Saddle up and go. We'll start you on a 1 ½ hour horseback ride, enjoying the scenery and then challenge you to a shoot off. After your horseback ride you will be shuttled to Kamas for a chance at shooting down the clay pigeons with an over and under, pump or single shot 12-gauge shot gun. After the fun we'll enjoy a good old fashioned Dutch oven lunch or dinner. Please call for details. Tour lasts approximately 4-5 hours. Transportation, lunch, equipment and guide are provided. Price varies based on size of the group.

Rafting/River Walk Combo: Since you're going to work your biceps on the raft anyway, why not even things out with an adventurous hike through a unique slot canyon in the Uinta National Forest. We'll start you out on a raft on the Weber River and afterwards take a detour to the Uintas, but not before stopping off for lunch at one of our favorite local cafés or picnicking in the mountains. After you are rested and ready to go we'll start the hike at Provo River Falls, come prepared for adventure on this tour.

Bike and Train: This tour will take you on the Deer Creek scenic bike loop; an easy to moderate graded dirt trail ride alongside Deer Creek Reservoir. At mile 3 or mile 7 you will jump one of the Heber Valley Railroad's steam or vintage diesel locomotives for a leisurely and scenic train ride back to the depot in Heber where you will meet your guide and be shuttled back to your hotel. This tour lasts approximately 3-4 hours not including transportation. Lunch included in tour.

Night Tours

Sunset Hike: Sometimes it's better to escape the hot summer sun by doing an evening hike. This tour offers you the opportunity to enjoy nature with the local wildlife. Join us after hours as the sun is getting ready to set and the animals are starting to make appearances. To begin the evening we will visit Rockcliff Nature Preserve's visitor center to get a better idea of what animals are indigenous to our area, what they look like and what kind of tracks they leave. While hiking enjoy a lakeside view of the Wasatch Mountain Range. Before or after your hike sit back and delight in a delicious Dutch oven or BBQ meal by the campfire. Please call for details.

Sunset Kayak Cruise: This is not your everyday cruise ship! Join us for an evening paddle trip around the lake, on one of our sit on top kayaks, accompanied by a fireside Dutch oven or BBQ dinner at an adjacent campsite. Please call for details.

Stargazer Hike: Leave your horoscope at home and come hike under the stars. Tours can be set up on an individual basis and will depart at 8:00pm or later. Enjoy gazing off into the clear night sky while your guide entertains you with mythological stories about the constellations. Star charts and red head lamps will be provided to help you find the constellations. Please call for details.

Full Moon Tours: A once a month opportunity! Join us for a hike or bike ride through the moonlit summer mountains of Park City. This is a tour for night owls that departs at 9:00pm. Please call for details.
