AUTHOR'S (s') NAME(s):

ARTICLE:

The Counselors of Real Estate (American Society of Real Estate Counselors) of the National Association of REALTORS[®] is pleased to accept your above mentioned Article* for publication in *Real Estate Issues*, subject to your acceptance of the following terms:

1. In consideration of publication of the Article by The Counselors of Real Estate, the Author(s) hereby transfers and assigns all right, title and interest, including copyrights, in and to the Article, to The Counselors of Real Estate of the National Association of REALTORS[®]. Author acknowledges that the rights granted herein consist of all rights in the Article and include, by way of illustration and not limitation, the rights to:

- (a) publish the Article as part of a collective work, titled *Real Estate Issues*, a separate work copyrighted by The Counselors of Real Estate;
- (b) publish the Article worldwide in any language;
- (c) distribute the Article by sale or otherwise, and in condensed or abbreviated format, provided the integrity of the Article is not diminished;

The Author(s) further represents and warrants that the Article contains no matter that is libelous or otherwise unlawful or which invades or infringes any proprietary rights (including, without limitation, any copyright) of any individual or entity. The Author shall indemnify, defend and hold The Counselors and its officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives harmless from and against any and all claims, suits, damages, losses, costs (including reasonable attorneys' fees) or other expenses that arise directly or indirectly out of or from a breach of this representation and warranty, including claims or suits asserting that the Article or this assignment to The Counselors of Real Estate infringes or otherwise violates any copyright, trademark, trade secret or other intellectual property or other rights of any third party.
